Mr Matthew Attwater has been appointed as the Child Safety Officer with specific responsibility for responding to any complaints made by staff, volunteers, parents or students in relation to Child Safety.

This statement will be disseminated to the school community through the staff handbook, parent information booklet, newsletters and through enrolment procedures.
