Dear Parents/Carers,

This Sunday is Pentecost Sunday

Gospel Summary:

There is much to be attentive to in this Sunday's short Gospel reading. First, Jesus appears to his disciples and says to them, "Peace be with you." Then he says, "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." He concludes by breathing on them the Holy Spirit, saying, "Whose sins you



forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." We see these three statements hinted at in the liturgical and sacramental life of the Church: "Peace be with you"—the Sign of Peace; "As the Father has sent me, so I send you"—the Dismissal of the Mass; and "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them. ... "—the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation.

Reflection for Families:

One of the greatest gifts we can give to our children and to our families is the gift of peace. Peace is a Fruit of the Holy Spirit, a visible sign to others that we are living under the guidance of the Holy Spirit and according to the laws and commands of God. Take time to think about the gift of Christ's peace in your own life. Do you have the gift of Christ's peace? Do you need the gift of Christ's peace? Where are you called to take the gift of Christ's peace today?

The Australian Government Office for the eSafety Commissioner has released an interactive tour titled 'Screen Smart Parent Tour.'


This 10 minute interactive tour is for parents of pre-teens and young teens (10-14 years old) but it wouldn't hurt if we all watched it to educate ourselves.







<u>Phonological Awareness Activities for Chatter Matters:</u>

Reading: When reading a text with your child, discuss words that have tricky meanings i.e.






Morphology: Morphological awareness is a skill that helps students read and spell. It involves breaking up words into their root word, prefixes, and suffixes. These can be added or taken away from a word to alter its meaning. For example, the word unhelpful can be broken into: a prefix – un (meaning not), root word – help, and a suffix – ful (meaning full of). This could be explained as: not full of help. The following activities will help



develop your child's morphological awareness and improve indirectly their fluency, reading comprehension, and spelling.
