Gospel Summary

In this coming Sunday's gospel, Jesus continued to try to help the disciples understand what was in store for him, but they did not understand what he was saying. They discussed among themselves who was the greatest. Placing a child in their midst, Jesus told the disciples that whoever receives a child in his name receives him.

Reflection for Parents

When Jesus speaks of receiving a child in his name, he is speaking of receiving those whom society sees as unimportant, those with no legal rights, and those with no identity. He is speaking of receiving the powerless and the vulnerable. Today, think about what you can do and are doing to help your children develop compassionate hearts for the poor, the vulnerable, and those in need. They learn best by watching and following your example. How are you showing them the way to love?

NAPLAN Results:

NAPLAN results for Yr 3 & 5 students arrived recently. As you will be aware there were some contentious issues at a government level about the reliability of results for students who sat the paper based tests compared to students who sat the online tests. This is still an ongoing issue. The tests are now available for pick up from your child's home-room teacher.

Sporting Schools Funding:

Unfortunately we were unsuccessful in receiving funding for Australian Sporting Schools Program for term 4 due to an extraordinary amount of schools applying. This in turn means that we cannot offer the Afterschool Program in term 4. We will apply for funding again at the end of term 4 and hopefully be able to run the program in term 1 of 2019.
