PBIS Focus of the Week: Expectations in the Office Area

Dear Parents/Carers,

This Sunday is the 2nd Sunday of Advent BE ON THE ALERT FOR SYMPTOMS OF INNER HOPE. LOVE, JOY AND PEACE this Advent Season.

The hearts of a great many have already been exposed to this virus and it is possible that people everywhere could come down with it in epidemic proportions. This could pose a serious threat to what has, up to now, been a fairly stable condition of conflict in the world.

Some signs and symptoms of The Advent Virus:

- A tendency to think and act spontaneously rather than on fears based on past experiences.
- An unmistakable ability to enjoy each moment.
