This event is taking place at a new location for 2021, the Chiltern Football Ground which is located at 99 Conness St, Chiltern VIC 3683. Below are some of the details to make this a fun, safe and exciting event for all.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ENTRY TO THE GROUND FOR CARS WILL BE BLOCKED OFF AT 10am DUE TO THE TRACK BEING USED FOR EVENTS.
