# CATHOLIC EDUCATION WEEK



This week students celebrated **Catholic Education Week**. They explored the history of the Catholic Education schooling and how it developed over the years both locally and abroad. Students discovered how the names of their house groups arrived of **Nagle** (*Nano Nagle was the founder of the Presentation Sisters, the order of nuns that founded St. Mary's*), **Donaghy** (*Mother Gertrude Donaghy was the first first superior of the teaching sisters*), and **O'Connor** (*Father Michael O'Connor Parish Priest of Rutherglen between 1995-1905 and was responsible getting teaching nuns to Rutherglen in 1901*).

The Grade 6's also designed a banner with their personal handprints and described in one word what made their Catholic School unique to them. Some of these reflections were heartwarming. Such as supportive; individualised learning; active; accepting; safe; spiritual; opportunities; loved; togetherness; hope; inclusive; peace; wellbeing; catholic identity; community; values; respect; education; technology; caring; sharing; creativity and happiness.

## **OR Code School Check-in:**

All organisations, including schools, are now to be registered with the Victorian State Government QR check in system. St. Mary's is now registered.

This means that every person that attends our school, whether indoor or outdoor, for longer than 15 minutes must scan the check in QR code. These QR code records will help with any future contact tracing that may be necessary in slowing the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19). Our unique St. Mary's QR code poster will be displayed outside every classroom, the office, both the front and rear entrance to the school, in the undercover area and the school hall.

## COVID Restrictions: On School Grounds During Drop Off and Pick up:

Just a reminder that if parents/visitors are on school grounds for more than 15 minutes the St. Mary's QR code needs to be scanned. Please stick to the 15 minutes. Particularly at pick up parents should remain in their cars and not congregate outside the school hall. Hopefully this may change as the year progresses.
