IMPORTANT: PLEASE Still Be Cautious

A bit more freedom in Victoria today with many restrictions being eased and more freedoms available to us which is good news. However we still all need to be cautious and very mindful that there are many cases of COVID in our local surrounding NE areas and all families still need to strictly follow the community & school COVID protocols that remain in place.

It is very important that no student is sent to school with any COVID symptoms.

Students, even with the mildest symptoms, of a cold, running nose, cough etc are not to be at school. If a student does present to school with these symptoms we will have to send them home. Thanks to all families who have been vigilant in this area.

Excerpt from School Operations Guidelines:

"Stay home when unwell and get tested:

The most important action school communities can take to reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19, is to ensure that any unwell staff and students remain at home and get tested, even with the mildest of symptoms.

Everyone should consider their health before they start work or attend school and ensure that they are free from coronavirus symptoms and have not had contact in the past 14 days with a person confirmed to have coronavirus or a person suspected to have coronavirus."

Face Masks Change:

All staff and students in Yr3-6 are required to wear a face mask inside classrooms however under the new School Operation guide released this week it is now not necessary for staff to wear a mask outside if they choose that option.

Drop Off & Pick up:

All parents and carers have been great in this area. Please just drop off and pick up your child from the rear car park. This system is working well. Only enter the school grounds if absolutely necessary.




