PBIS Expectations: Expectations in the Church

This Sunday is Palm Sunday



Palm Sunday is the first Day of Holy Week. It is when we remember how Jesus entered Jerusalem riding on a donkey. It is called Palm Sunday because the people were so happy to see Jesus and knew that he was very important, so they took branches from the Palm and Olive Trees that lined the road. They waved them in the air shouting 'Hosanna' (which means 'God Saves' in Hebrew) and put some of them on the road to make it easier for the donkey to walk on the rocky road.

This Sunday (Palm Sunday) we begin Holy Week. Holy Week is the week before Easter Sunday. It begins with Palm Sunday, then Holy Thursday, Good Friday and ends with Holy Saturday. Easter Sunday is not part of Holy Week, but rather marks the beginning of the Easter season of the Liturgical year.


END of TERM ONE

Code Red School Closures



Our school has been identified as a school in a high risk bushfire area and has now been placed on the Bushfire At-Risk Register.

This means that all schools, kindergartens and licensed child care centres that have been identified as being at high fire risk and on the Department's Victoria-wide Bushfire At-Risk Register will close on days declared Code Red.

Schools and services not on the Bushfire At-Risk Register will remain open, unless directly threatened by fire or another emergency.

Where possible, three (3) days notice of a planned closure will be provided. However, experience indicates that a Code Red fire danger rating day may be forecast at short notice. Parents and guardians should expect that in some instances less than three days notice may be provided. Once the final decision to close is confirmed at 12 noon the day prior, this decision will not change – regardless of any changes in the weather forecast. This will help limit confusion and help families plan for how their children will be cared for when their school is closed. When a school is closed in response to bushfire risk, no one, including staff, contractors and other users, will be permitted on site.

The Power Saving Bonus is a \$250 Payment

On 24 March 2023, a new round of the Power Saving Bonus program commenced.

Victorian households are now able to receive a new \$250 payment, including any households that received a payment through previous rounds of the program.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Absenteeism - Our Legal Requirement

It is a legal requirement that all schools must follow up any daily unexplained absences by 9.30 am.

If your child is going to be away from school or arriving late for any reason the school **must be notified.** The simplest way to do this is through **PAM.**

If your child is an **unexplained absence** you will receive an **SMS** asking you to contact the school and a phone call if necessary. If there is no answer then the **emergency contacts** for your family will be contacted and then if there is still no answer the police are contacted. These steps are followed to ensure that we know that your child is **safe.**
