PBIS Expectations: Expectations on the School Crossing

This Sunday is the First Sunday for Advent.



This Sunday marks the beginning of the season of **Advent**. Advent comes from the Latin word meaning "coming." **Jesus is coming!** Advent is a joyous season when we prepare for His arrival - the Birth of Jesus on Christmas Day.

The **Advent Wreath** is a significant symbol of Advent and it would be wonderful if all families could have an Advent wreath displayed in a prominent place in your home to help your family prepare for the "Coming of Jesus."

This Sunday we light the First Candle on the Advent Wreath, the Candle of Hope. **The Coming of Jesus Gives Us HOPE!**

THE ADVENT WREATH

The word 'Advent' means 'coming'. When we light the candles on the wreath, it symbolises the coming of light (Jesus) into the world.

- à Candle 1 (violet): represents hope
- å Candle 2 (violet): represents peace
- å Candle 3 (rose): represents joy
- å Candle 4 (violet): represents love

The central white candle is lit on Christmas Day and represents Christ.



This Advent we will learn, act and pray for a more just and fair world – a world full of hope, peace, joy, and love. Make your own Advent wreath.

Please login to PAM and complete the survey.







Apply for a school travel pass

Introduction

The School Student Transport Scheme (SSTS) gives eligible school students free or subsidised travel between home and school on NSW public transport, including trains, buses, ferries and light rail.

Depending on where you're travelling, you may receive a free school travel pass, a School Opal card, or both.

Eligible cards are automatically updated for the new school year, so you'll only need to apply if you're:

- applying for a school travel pass for the first time
- changing name, school and/or address, or
- requesting an additional pass as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation.

Eligibility

You need to live a minimum distance from your school to be eligible for a free school travel pass. The minimum distance varies according to the year/grade you are enrolled in, in that calendar year:

- Years K to 2 (Infants): no minimum distance
- Years 3 to 6 (Primary): 1.6 kilometres straight line distance or 2.3 kilometres walking or further
- Years 7 to 12 (Secondary): 2 kilometres straight line distance or 2.9 kilometres walking or further.

What you need

A valid email address.

Applications must be made by a parent or legal guardian if you're under 16 years of age. If you're 16 years or older you need to complete and sign the application form yourself.

How to apply

- 1. Select the 'Apply online' button.
- 2. Complete the online application.
- 3. Note down your application ID number, starting with the prefix 'N' or 'UN'.
- 4. You'll then be able to track the status of your application.

Note: The drop down lists does not always work while attempting to register on a mobile phone or tablet, therefore a computer is recommended.
